Yn anffodus, mae nifer o heolydd o fewn y sir sydd angen sylw brys, mae'r ffactorau dros yr arafwch yn ymwneud a blaenoriaethau, anghenion staffio ac yn bennaf oll cyllid. Adroddwyd bod yr heol tuag at Brynarth a Thrawsgoed wedi ei hadnewyddu yn ddiweddar, ac felly, cytunodd y Clerc i wneud ymholiadau pellach gyda'r Cynghorydd Sirol, Ifan Davies am y sefyllfa.

Matters from meeting held 24 June 2021

1. **Road conditions** – the Clerk reported that no further correspondence had come to hand from the County Council with regards to road conditions. Unfortunately, there are numerous roads within the county that need urgent attention, factors leading to this is the need to prioritise, staffing issues and the general financial situation. It was reported that the road from Brynarth towards Trawscoed had been resurfaced lately, therefore, the Clerk agreed to peruse the matter further with the County Councillor Ifan Davies.

8. Ceredigion Ara Committee 18 January 2022 via Zoom – Mair Humphreys agreed to attend.
9. An email was received from Claire McNamara introducing herself as a Community Connector for the Community Support and Development Service.
10. A letter was received from Ben Lake informing us of the result of the Community Banking Survey that was held recently. He has arranged a series of meetings with HSBC, Nat Wales, Barclays and Lloyds to discuss the reduction and decline in banking services in rural communities.

13. Councillor Siarl Owen, Tynddraenen agreed to place flowers on the monument, the Clerk agreed to inform him of which month.
