Ar gychwyn y cyfarfod cydymdeimlwyd a Dafydd a Tomos Jones ar farwolaeth ei brawd, Evan Jones, Maesymeillion, Tregaron (Bronwenllwyd gynt). Bu Evan yn Gynghorwr ar Gyngor Cymuned Ystrad Meurig hyd at Rhagfyr 2014.

### Materion yn Codi

**Cyflwr heolydd:** adroddodd y Clerc ei bod hi'n parhau i gysylltu efo'r Cyngor Sir am gyflwr yr heolydd yn y manau canlynol: Maescamddwr, Swyddffynnon, Rhiw Penderlwyngoch, Rhiw Tynlon, Grid Comin, Tŷ Nant, Tynygraig a heol Chwarel yr Hendre. Cytunodd i gysylltu efo Ian Williams yn y Cyngor Sir eto. Nodwyd hefyd bod ardaloedd eraill i weld yn cael gwella ei heolydd, gyda tarmac a chippings wedi ei gosod ar sawl heol yn ddiweddar. Addawodd y Clerc hefyd i gael gair pellach efo'r Cynghorydd Ifan Davies.

Adroddwyd hefyd bod gwter ger Tŷ Capel / Llys yr Awel, Swyddffynnon wedi llenwi a bod angen edrych ymhellach ar hyn oherwydd bod dwr yn mynd i lawr drwy'r pentref.

### Gohebiaeth:

1. Praesept 2021/2022 – cadarnhaodd y Clerc ei bod wedi hawlio'r praespet ar gyfer 2021/2022 a oedd yn gyfanswm o £2,138.50.
2. Derbyniwyd infois oddi wrth Mary Buchanan, Blaenpentre am dorri'r gwair yn y Parc (2020) – cytunwyd i dalu £60.00 am y gwaith – cytunwyd gan bawb.
3. Western Power Distribution – derbyniwyd siec am £15.22
4. CSC Cais Cynllunio A210248 – Adeiladu to dros yard concryd – dim gwrthwynebiad. Datganwyd diddordeb gan y Cyng. Siarl Owen.
5. CSC Cais Cynllunio A210265 – Adeiladu sied i gadw tail (manure) – dim gwrthwynebiad. Datganwyd diddordeb gan y Cyng. David M a Tomos Jones.
6. Ar gais Dr Angie Polkey cytunwyd i ysgrifennu at Banc Barcalys parthed ei hymwneud a tanwydd ffosil. Nodwyd hefyd bod y Maes Chwarae yn cael ei drin fel "village green" ac ni fyddai modd i unrhyw un blannu coed/planhigion yno. Doedd dim gwrthwynebiad gan y Cyngor Cymuned i'r cyhoedd ei ddefnyddio fel man chwarae a chymdeithasu.
7. Ysiwriant BHIB – derbyniwyd cadarnhad mae £319.41 fyddai cost adnewyddu ein ysiwriant am y cyfnod 1af Mehefin 2021 – 31 Mai 2022. Cytunwyd i dalu gan bawb.
8. Barclays ar 29/1/2021 = £1,886.58 ac yna 30/3/2021 = £966.48.

## **Minutes of meeting held Thursday, 4 May 2021 at Gwnnws Church Hall.**

Minutes of meeting held 12 November 2020 were accepted as a correct record.

At the beginning sympathy was extended to Dafydd and Tomos Jones on the death of their brother, Evan Jones, Maesymeillion, Tregaron (Bronwenllwyd). Evans was a Councillor on this Community Council until December 2014.

### **Matters arising**

**Condition of roads:** the Clerk reported that she was in contact with the County Council in relation to the condition of the roads at the following locations: Maescamddwr, Swyddffynnon, Rhiw Penderlwyngoch, Rhiw Tynlon, Grid Comin, Tŷ Nant, Tynygraig & Chwarel yr Hendre. She agreed to contact Ian Williams in the County Council again. It was also raised that other local areas had seen improvement to their roads with tarmac and chippings. The Clerk agreed to discuss this further with Councillor Ifan Davies.

It was also reported that the gutter at Chapel House/Llys yr Awel, Swyddffynnon was blocked and this needed further investigation because water was now travelling down through the village.

### **Correspondence:**

1. Precept 2021/2022 – the Clerk confirmed that she had claimed the precept for 2021/2022 which was a total of £2,138.50.
2. Invoice was received from Mary Buchanan, Blaenpentre for cutting the grass at the Maes Chwarae (2020) – it was agreed to pay £60.00 for the work – all agreed.
3. Western Power Distribution – cheque for £15.22 was received.
4. CCC Planning Application A210248 – Roof over concrete yard – no objection. Councillor Siarl Owen declared an interest.
5. CCC Cais Cynllunio A210265 – Erection of shed to store manure – no objection. Councillors David M a Tomos Jones declared an interest.
6. At the request of Dr Angie Polkey it was agreed to write to Barclays Bank in relation to our concern of them supporting fossil fuel. It was also noted that the Maes Chware is treated as village green and there would be no means to plant trees/vegetables etc. There was no objection for anyone to use the facilities as a park to play games and community gatherings.
7. BHIB Insurance – renewal of insurance would be a cost of £319.41 for the period 1<sup>st</sup> June 2021 – 31 May 2022. All present agreed to pay.
8. Barclays on 29/1/2021 = £1,886.58 and 30/3/2021 = £966.48.
